## WHITE WINES OF THE MONTH

### Kumala Zenith Chenin Blanc/Chardonnay 2008

A clean, attractive light-coloured wine with a green tint to confirm freshness. Great on its own or with full-flavoured chicken dishes, Thai cuisine and vegetarian meals.

### Lomond Sauvignon Blanc

This wine is more tropical in profile, with fragrances of ripe fig. It's light on the nose and crisp in the mouth, ending in a sweet finish. Perfect with creamy fish dishes.

### Nederburg Sauvignon Blanc

An intense wine with a very clear expression of fresh fruit. It makes a great accompaniment to green salads or chicken pastas.
